	Feed Hygiene Registration	You need to register as a R13 (livestock farms, not mixing feed) business with your local Trading standards office. Format AA 123 B 4567	Legal Requirement	Free	One time process
Selling your Pork	Registered Food Business	You need to register as a Food Business with your local trading standards (England Wales, Northern Ireland), or Environmental Health Department (Scotland). You will be assessed and provided with a food Hygiene rating 1-5 (England Wales, Northern Ireland) or Pass/Fail (Scotland). Please Note this needs to be completed at least 30days before you start selling.		Free	You need to review/renew your registration every 3 years.
